## **Guidelines**

All applicants will be notified by mid-August as to their status for the showcase.

#### All authors chosen to participate in the local author showcase:

- Must have a published book to participate in the event
- Must bring copies of their own book and are welcome to bring give away items, etc.
- If they are selling their own book: Need a valid seller's permit. Must handle all cash/credit transactions (or bring someone with them to handle transactions. Library staff cannot handle monetary transactions)
- Authors cannot participate in the showcase more than once in a three-year period
- Authors must reside in the Bay Area to qualify for the event

#### Authors will be selected for the showcase in the following manner:

We will accept 12 authors. Completion of the application does not guarantee acceptance.

We will take authors from the Tri-Valley area first, then authors closest to this area, etc.

We may also pick authors based on their book's audience or content, to ensure a mix of books written for different ages and in different genres. The library reserves the right to accept or refuse any applicant at its discretion.

Authors can submit a copy of their book for review, but it will <u>not</u> be returned to them. It may be added to the library's collection, donated, or used as a door prize at the event.

There is no fee to participate in the local author showcase.

### What will the library provide?

- One 6' table and two chairs per author
- Flyers publicizing the event, which will be distributed out in the community, shared with local libraries and cities, and publicity on the library's social media accounts
- Author's name and book title on the event program handed out during the event
- Light refreshments during the event
- Confirmed participants will receive a checklist to help them promote and prepare for the event. Everyone's help in promoting the event will increase our success.
